Medicare has been experimenting on people with diabetes. In 2011, CMS created a "bidding program" to reduce cost, maintain access and provide quality care. However, it failed on all accounts.

Required patients to switch from a known supplier to another, lower-cost supplier

Drove up hospitalizations & mortality

Failed to save money for Medicare






